- 1 לְכוּ נִרְנְנָה לַיהוָה
נְרִיעָה לְצוּר יִשְׁעֵנוּ
Come, let us sing joyously to the Lord,
let us shout out to the Rock of our rescue.
- 2 נִקְדְּמָה פָּנֵינוּ בְּתוֹדָה
בְּזִמְרוֹת נְרִיעַ לּוֹ
Let us greet Him in acclaim,
in song let us shout out to Him.
- 3 כִּי אֵל גָּדוֹל יִי
וּמֶלֶךְ גָּדוֹל עַל-כָּל-אֱלֹהִים
For a great God is the Lord
and great king over all the gods.
- 4 אֲשֶׁר בְּיָדוֹ מַחְקְרֵי-אָרֶץ
וְתוֹעֲפוֹת הַרִים לּוֹ
In whose hands are the depths of the earth,
and the peaks of the mountains are His.
- 5 אֲשֶׁר-לוֹ הַיָּם וְהוּא עָשָׂהוּ
וַיִּבְשֹׁת יָדָיו יַצְרוּ
His is the sea and He made it,
and the dry land His hands did fashion.
- 6 בֹּאוּ נִשְׁתַּחֲוֶה וְנִכְרַעַה
נִבְרָכָה לְפָנֵי-יְיָ עֲשֵׂנוּ
Come, let us bow and kneel,
bend the knee before the Lord our maker.
- 7 כִּי הוּא אֱלֹהֵינוּ
וְאֲנַחְנוּ עִם מְרַעִיתוֹ
וְצֹאן יָדוֹ
הַיּוֹם אִם-בְּקֹלוֹ תִשְׁמָעוּ
For He is our God
and we are the people He tends
and the flock of His hand.
If you would only listen to His voice!
- 8 אַל-תִּקְשׁוּ לְבַבְכֶם כַּמֶּרִיבָה
כִּיּוֹם מַסָּה בַּמִּדְבָּר
“Do not harden your heart as at Meribah,
as on the day at Massah in the wilderness,
- 9 אֲשֶׁר נִסּוּנִי אֲבוֹתֵיכֶם
בְּחַזְנוֹנִי גַם-רָאוּ פַעְלֵי
when your forefathers tested Me,
tried Me, though they has seen My acts.
- 10 אַרְבָּעִים שָׁנָה אֶקְוֹט בְּדוֹר
וְאָמַר עִם תַּעֲיִ לִבָּב הֵם
וְהֵם לֹא-יָדְעוּ דַרְכֵי
Forty years I loathed a generation,
and I said, ‘They are a people of wayward heart.
And they do not know My ways.’
- 11 אֲשֶׁר-נִשְׁבַּעְתִּי בְּאַפִּי
אִם-יָבֹאוּן אֶל-מְנוּחָתִי
Against them I swore in My wrath,
‘They shall not come to My resting place.’”
